The PsyD program may accept credit for substantially equivalent graduate-level coursework completed at approved universities or schools of professional psychology, up to 27 credit hours. A maximum of 36 credit hours of credit may be waived with the approval of the doctoral program advisor for those entering with a master's degree; a maximum of 27 credit hours may be transferred for those entering with a BA or BS. Credit is granted only for courses in which the grade obtained was a B or higher and only if the courses were taken within seven years prior to the beginning of the student's doctoral program. The expected timeline to completion for a student entering with a completed master's degree in a related field with approved credit for an equivalent year of supervised clinical training can expect to complete the program in 4 years. Students entering with a completed master's degree in a related field without approved credit for an equivalent year of supervised clinical training can expect to complete the program in 5 years. It is not possible to complete the program in less than 4 years due to our clinical training requirements.
