Notes Concerning the Bachelor of Arts Degree

Major in Criminal Justice Administration

General Degree requirements

- New students should take the Roosevelt University Assessment test before registering for their first semester. Students will not be allowed to register for a second semester at Roosevelt until the RUA is completed.
- Students must successfully complete 30 semester hours of credit at Roosevelt University (residency requirement).
- Students must have a 2.0 grade point average to graduate.
- Students must complete a minimum of 21 semester hours of coursework at the 300-level at Roosevelt.

Specific Requirements and Notes for the BA in Criminal Justice

- CJL 200, Introduction to Criminal Justice, is a pre-requisite for all other CJL courses.
- The University Writing Requirement is a pre-requisite for all 300-level CJL courses.
- Specific Pre-requisites:
 - CJL 250 (Criminal Law) is a pre-requisite for CJL 330 (Criminal Justice & the Constitution)
 - CJL 240 (Intro to Criminology) is a pre-requisite for CJL 356 (Principles of Criminal Behavior)
 - CJL 305 and 356 are pre/co-requisites for CJL 390 (Senior Seminar)
- Students must successfully complete a minimum of 15 semester hours in Criminal Justice courses in the major at Roosevelt.
- Grade of C- or higher required in all Criminal Justice Leadership courses
- **Functional Area:** The Functional Area is defined as a sequence of related courses in a discipline or an interdisciplinary area. For example, students may elect six courses in one discipline like Sociology (and may earn a Minor, if requirements are met). Or students may choose six courses in an interdisciplinary area like the Humanities (combining courses in, say, Speech, Literature, and Gender Studies). Appropriate Functional Areas will be approved by an Academic Advisor in consultation with the Program Director. OLED 320 may substitute as one course in any Functional Area.
- **General Education Requirements:** PLS 390 (Social Science Seminar), PLS 391 (Natural Science Seminar), and PLS 392 (Humanities Seminar) may count as 6 semester hours towards General Education Requirements.
- **General Electives:** Students who have successfully completed an accredited police academy, fire academy, or EMT academy may petition to be awarded 12 credit hours towards general elective requirements at the discretion of the Program Director.
