UNDERGRADUATE

INTERNSHIPS: In future, HOSM 385 Internship will no longer be listed in the schedule of classes. In order to register for this class a student must first verify with their advisors that the Internship is an appropriate course selection. Students must then make an appointment to see Dr. Bober who will be overseeing internships, to discuss their job interests, goals and employment strategy. Current resumes should be submitted to Dr. Bober in advance of that appointment.

GRADUATE

HOSM 490 Graduate Thesis and **HOSM 499** Graduate Project will not be listed in the course schedule. An individualized section registration for must be submitted with the working title of the thesis or project. These registrations do not have to be submitted by the term's registration deadline. These registrations cannot be completed online.

Each term (except Summers) that the graduate thesis or project is not completed, the student must register for an extension. The **extension section** is a zero semester hour section for which there is a \$100 fee that allows the student to continue with the use of the library and other university services. The extension section registration cannot be completed online.
