Federal Direct Plus Loans allow parents with **credit approval** to borrow money to pay for the educational expenses of their dependent undergraduate student. If this loan is not credit approved, the student may apply for additional federal loans. The student must be enrolled at least **half-time** (6 hours).

Federal Direct Plus Loan Amounts:

Under the Federal Direct Plus Program, parents can borrow up to the student's Cost of Attendance minus any estimated financial assistance the student has or will be awarded during the loan period.

The parent must complete a Federal Direct Plus Loan Master Promissory Note. This application can be completed online at the following website: <https://dlenote.ed.gov/empn/index.jsp>

Federal Direct Plus Loan Disbursements:

The government must have a valid Plus Promissory Note on file before any funds will be released to the school. If you apply for a loan that covers two semesters, loan funds will be disbursed once per term. Loans borrowed for only one semester will be sent in one disbursement. The government will deduct a nominal loan origination fee before the money is disbursed to Roosevelt University.
