



## Paralegal Studies Program

### Spring 2020 Chicago Part-Time Evening Schedule March 17, 2020 – May 2021

In the Part-Time Evening Course Schedule (March start), post-baccalaureate certificate students are able to complete the program in a little over one year. Classes are eight to ten weeks in length. The courses follow a logical sequencing order in the schedule allowing students to build on concepts as they go through the program. On-campus classes are offered at Roosevelt University's Auditorium Building located at 430 S. Michigan Avenue in Chicago.

The schedule offers a variety of delivery methods. Courses are conveniently offered on-campus, online, and in “hybrid” mode (combining face-to-face meetings and online interactions). The delivery format of each course is pre-determined by the program and the schedule meets American Bar Association guidelines with respect to online delivery of legal specialty courses. Pursuant to ABA guidelines, students must take at least nine semester hours or the equivalent of legal specialty courses through traditional classroom instruction.
