The **T**eacher **E**ducation **A**ssistance for **C**ollege and **H**igher Education (TEACH) Grant was developed by the U.S. Department of Education to provide grants to students who are completing or plan to complete degree course work needed to begin a career in teaching. As a condition for receiving a TEACH Grant, approved students are required to commit to teach as full-time teachers in a high need academic field, at an elementary or secondary school that services students from low-income families, for at least four school years, within 8 years of completing a degree program. If the service obligation is not completed, the TEACH Grant funds are converted to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan that must be repaid to the U.S. Department of Education. You are responsible for the payment of any institutional charges due to Roosevelt University by the published due dates.

**Terms and Conditions / Eligibility Requirements**

- I have already completed the 2019-2020 FAFSA and meet the eligibility requirements for Federal Student Aid. I understand that I must complete the FAFSA every academic year.
- I am pursuing my first Bachelor's Degree or Master's degree:
