Eligible award amounts are determined by Federal requirements, grade level, and enrollment status on the date of award disbursement. The TEACH Grant can be converted to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan that must be repaid with interest to the U.S. Department of Education when the teaching obligation is not fulfilled. Submitting this application is not a guarantee that you will be eligible or approved for the Federal TEACH Grant. Applicants must meet all 2023-2024 "Student Eligibility Requirements" for consideration.
